- 1. Make sure you have all of the required parts for installation. (see checklist below)
- 2. Remove stock (OEM) fuel cap.
- 3. On all bikes listed above you will be re-using the OEM vent system. The Halo Base will only replace the aluminum ring.
- 4. Separate aluminum ring from plastic vent system/base by removing the bolts.
- 5. Install OEM gasket and plastic vent system following by the Driven Halo base.
- 6. Make sure both base and cap gaskets are installed.
- 7. Install the screws into the fuel cap and tighten to 6 FT/LB. It is highly recommended to use blue Loctite while installing these screws. Install the ¼ turn cap by pushing down and turning clockwise until it locks into place. You can release the cap by pushing down and turning it counter-clockwise.

\*Note: If you wish to use the OE rubber trim, trimming will be required on some models.






